COVID-19 Safety Policy

When our conference meets this May, the national COVID-19 emergency will have ended, but the infection caused by this virus is still prevalent and contagious, and can cause life threatening illness. Because of this we have written the following policy to be in keeping with the policies of our location (Camp Kieve - KWE) and of Maine. Please read the below policy and your registration indicates you agree to follow these protocols. If conditions change and we need to change this policy, we will let all registrants know.

COVID-19 Safety Policy:

To ensure the health and safety of all participants at the 2023 Great Mother and New Father Conference, we ask attendees to commit to these actions:

- Mask in all indoor public spaces, such as Innisfree, restrooms, the art gallery, and the dining hall (except when eating during meals) and in common areas indoors during the event.
- Bring at least three rapid antigen tests for use during the week: upon arrival, and 2-3 days after travel, and if symptoms develop.
- Be prepared to test if you develop COVID symptoms during the week, and be prepared to depart if you test positive for COVID during the week.
- We strongly recommend obtaining vaccinations and boosters to protect against COVID-19 infection and its serious consequences, according to eligibility by age group and medical condition.

Further strategies for health and precautions we recommend include:

- Limiting high-risk or high-exposure activities in the days leading up to the conference (avoiding crowds, using ventilation and physical spacing, wearing masks in enclosed spaces, etc.).
- Take a rapid antigen or other test and confirm a negative result before traveling to the event;
- Wear a high-quality mask (N95 or KN95) when on public transportation and traveling to the event.
- We will strongly encourage all windows to be open during the week to increase ventilation. You may want to bring extra warm bedding, layers of clothing.

These additional measures can help protect the valued immunocompromised and elders among us, in addition to keeping us all healthy.
